Re: Coordinated Support for Displaced Students

The Butte County Office of Education, local school districts, charters and the California Department of Education are actively working on a process for supporting students displaced by the Camp Fire. This process will be shared with school districts, charter schools, and the general public as soon as possible. Information will be posted on the BCOE website, distributed to school districts, charter schools, and local government agencies to post on their websites, and shared with the local news media.

It is the singular objective of Paradise Unified School District (PUSD), its board, administration, and certificated and classified staff, to reunite all PUSD students with teachers and staff in a safe and meaningful educational environment, as soon as practicable. The work to do so has begun in earnest, and it will not stop until that goal is achieved. Additional information will be posted on the PUSD webpage as it becomes available.

Golden Feather Union Elementary School District intends to reopen as soon as it is safe to do so and is currently reaching out to parents and families.

Charter schools in Paradise are working on contingency locations for their school operations. Students currently enrolled in a charter school located in Paradise are encouraged to check their school website for updated information.
