



VICTOR VALLEY COLLEGE PATHWAY TO LAW SCHOOL PROGRAM

VVC has an exciting new program designed to facilitate a student's journey through higher education toward the legal profession, including a guided pathway to law school and or the legal profession. This program is a product of the collaboration between the California State Bar Coalition for Access and Fairness and the California Community College Chancellor's office administered by California Law Inc.

This is a fabulous program that offers mentoring, individualized counselors dedicated to this program and transfer shepherding assistance. It is known as a 2+2+3 program that guides the student every step of the way through their educational journey. Students spend two years at the community college, 2 years at the four year university and then 3 years in a law school program. Participating and receiving 4 year and law school institutions include **UCLA, USC, UC Irvine, UC Davis, UC Berkeley, Loyola Marymount LA, University of San Francisco, Pepperdine, and Santa Clara University**. VVC is only the 30th community college admitted to this program and we are very proud to offer this program beginning with the 2018-2019 academic year.

There will be a mandatory orientation scheduled soon for all interested students and students ready to submit application for this program. It is open to any major of study as long as the core curriculum requirements are met.
