COVID-19 Guidelines/Procedures for Students
2021-2022 School Year

Under the current CDPH guidance, the following guidelines must be followed:

Face Mask Requirements:

- All Students, regardless of vaccination status must wear masks indoors, unless exempt.
- Guidance from CDPH will be communicated with families as changes occur.
- All Staff are required to wear masks when sharing indoor spaces with students.
- Currently, the guidance for masks applies to all indoor spaces in the school setting when students are present.
- Students and staff are not required to wear masks outdoors.

EXEMPTIONS: Assessing for exemption due to a medical condition, mental health condition, disability that prevents wearing a mask, or hearing impairment is a medical determination and therefore MUST be made by a physician, nurse Practitioner, or other licensed medical professional practicing under the license of a physician.

Enforcement of face mask requirements/mandate:

- Students will be required to show masks as they enter the campus.
- Additional masks will be available in the front office and/or in classrooms and facilitation rooms for students who lose their mask throughout the day.
- Parents/guardians of those students who continuously come to school without a face mask will be contacted and will assist accordingly. This may include discussion on distance learning and independent study options with Excelsior.

Student suspected of COVID symptoms:

- Student will be quarantined in a designated location.
- Student will be picked up by parent/guardian
- If a student or a member of the household has been COVID tested and is awaiting results, do not bring the student to campus until negative result is received.

Additional Information:

- As of now, there are no social distancing requirements.
- There is no requirement for temperature checks currently.
- No parent/guardian visits to classrooms.

COVID Guidelines 2021-2022

- Facilitation meetings through Zoom. As much as possible Zoom educational team meetings are preferred and encouraged and will be held quarterly with the facilitator (may be more frequent when needed). If needed, the meetings can be done on campus, but it is not preferred.
- Masks are required while indoors.
- We will still clean and sanitize regularly and we will still complete contact tracing through attendance.
- If choosing to complete courses via independent study, Zoom classes are required for English and Math.
