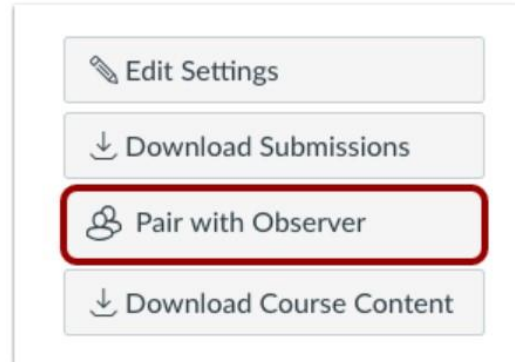
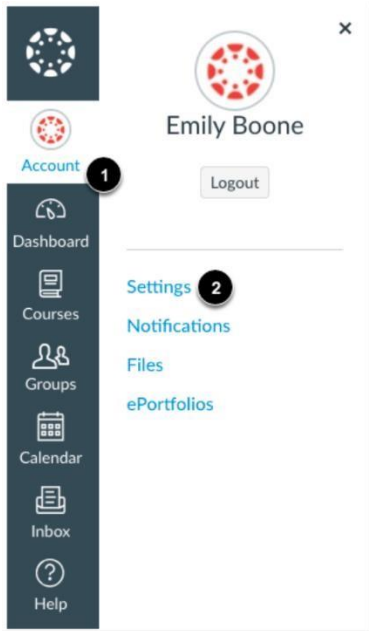


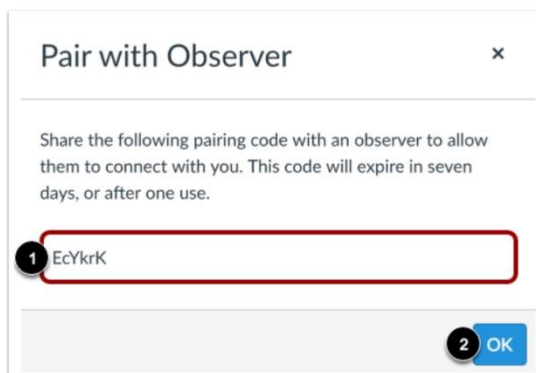
CANVAS Parent Account Setup

***You will need to access your student's CANVAS account to obtain a Pairing Code for your account setup.**

1. On your student's account left side menu bar, click **Account** and then **Settings**.
2. At the top right side of the new window click on **Pair with Observer**.



3. Your pairing code will appear. Record this code as you will use it for your Parent Account setup.


