### COMMUNITY

Description: Excelsior Charter School (ECS) serves the secondary grade (7th - 12th) educational needs of the entirety of San Bernardino County through our countywide benefit charter authorization from the San Bernardino County Board of Education.

Location: Located in the southern portion of the U.S. state of California and is located within the Inland Empire area. San Bernardino County spans an area from south of the San Bernardino Mountains in San Bernardino Valley, to the Nevada border and the Colorado River.

Population: The county of San Bernardino is currently home to approximately 2,181,654 people and is the largest county in the contiguous United States.

According to the most recent data per the U.S. Census Bureau, San Bernardino's ethnic distribution is currently as follows: 76.6% Caucasian, 54.4% Hispanic or Latino, 3.6% two or more races, 9.4% African American, 8% Asian, 2.1% American Indian and Alaska Native, 0.5% Native American and Pacific Islander.

### HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE

Description: Excelsior Charter Schools is a public charter serving grades 7-12 within San Bernardino County with campuses located in San Bernardino, Victorville, North Victorville, Phelan, Barstow, Ontario, and Redlands.

Accreditation: Western Association of Schools and Colleges six-year accreditation through June 30, 2028.

Enrollment: Current Enrollment is 2,194.

Class Load: Six (6) classes required for grades 9-11, five (5) classes required for grade 12. Students can participate via independent study, on-campus, or remote synchronous instruction.

Faculty: 75 teaching faculty; 3 guidance counselors; 7 administrators, 7 principals.

High School Grade Point Average: Grades 9-12. Marks earned in ALL courses from freshman through senior year counted.

Academic Grade Point Average: Academic GPA- All courses taken except for those listed as nonacademic. Advanced placement courses, and UC/CSU-approved courses taken at local community colleges will be weighted (A= 5 points) on the student's Academic GPA and Total GPA. (Non-Academic Courses – P.E. and Electives)

### CURRICULUM

Excelsior provides all students the opportunity to complete an A-G graduation course sequence. College-Prep courses are designated with a “P” on transcripts.

Honors courses: (Designated with a “+” on transcript) students can complete dual enrollment courses as well as CCAP classes in core areas.

Advanced Placement: Excelsior Charter Schools does not offer AP courses. Students are encouraged to complete dual enrollment courses.

Other Programs: Excelsior Charter Schools offers Special Education, Work Experience, Career Technical Education, and credit recovery.
